

Bishop's Visitation on Sunday, November 13th!

The Right Reverend Jeffery D. Lee, the Bishop Provisional of the Diocese of Milwaukee will be visiting Trinity Church in just a few weeks.

In recognition that this will likely be the only visitation Bishop Lee will be making to us during his brief tenure, we would like to welcome him heartily into our midst.

Please make your plans to attend this special day. The Bishop will be at both liturgies. He will also greet our children at the beginning of their Sunday school classes, and he will lead a brief adult forum in the Parish Hall from 9:10 - 9:40 am as well.

Join the fun and help the community. This is Trinity's main fundraiser for Outreach. Our auction takes place virtually and in person for the first time in three years.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3RD AT NOON UNTIL THE END OF THE IN PERSON AUCTION SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5TH @ 8:30 p.m.

Join us in the fellowship hall at church for the in-person auction on November 5th from 6:30 to 9:00 p.m.

Bidding will continue via your phone

Go to the web site and register before the auction starts so you are ready to bid!

FAQs and details of the 2022 Awesome Auction process

Q1: Can I share this auction to non-parishioners of Trinity Church?

A1: YES! Simply send them the auction site link for them to access.

Q2: Do I need to create an account to view the online auction items?

A2: Not if you are only viewing items. You will need to create an account in order to place a bid.

Q3: How do I bid on an item?

A3:

- 1. Log in to your participant account.
- 2. View the item page on which you want to bid.
- 3. Enter your bid amount (be mindful of "Minimum Bid Increments" and the amount of "Next Bid" shown in the "Bidding" box. If your bid is less than the amount of "Next Bid," you will receive an error to update your bid amount).
- 4. Select the bid type (Exact).
- 5. Click the "Place My Bid" button.

Q4: I cannot attend the auction in person or be attentive to bidding during Saturday night. How can I still participate in the auction?

A4:

Bid through "Proxy Bid".

- a. Sign in to your account after the auction begins on Thursday, November 3rd at Noon.
- b. Bid on the interested items with the highest amount you would bid for the item and select Proxy as the type of bid (NOT exact bid). The site will continue to bid for you when you are Outbid, but only up to highest bid amount that you set.
- c. Click the "Place My Bid" button.
- 2. Make a general donation to Outreach.
 - a. There will be some fixed denominations available for "Buy Now" to make a donation to the general Outreach Fund.

Q5: What kind of notifications will I receive from 32auctions.com?

A5: During Online Bidding

- Bid confirmations
- Outbid notifications (email and/or texts, if you add your phone number & opt-in under your account)
- Watchlist notifications (you choose which items by clicking the heart icon on the item)
- Auction Ending notification (24-hour notice)

Q6: Is there a way to make the image of the basket larger?

A6: Yes, come in person or online - right click on the image and open in another tab or window and the picture will be larger.

Q7: What if I have a question about the auction?

A7: Click the "Contact Us" on the auction site and the email addresses of the administrators will be shown. You can reach out to any of them. Trinity's Melissa Paradowski can answer questions regarding the site, Beth Vogel can answer payment questions and Jill Paradowski will be able to answer general auction and pick-up questions.

Q8: On what web browsers can I view the auction site?

A8: The latest versions of Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari, Microsoft Edge, Internet Explorer, and mobile browsers.

- For those bidding virtually and not attending the in-person auction should plan on picking up their items at church on Sunday, November 6th or make arrangements with church or Jill to pick the items up prior to November 13th. If this is not possible, please plan with Jill for other arrangements.
- All payments will be due by Monday, November 14th
- Payments will be accepted by (1) check the night of the auction or mailed to the church office with
 "auction" in the memo or (2) electronically through Trinity's website via this <u>safe Vanco link</u>; or click on
 "Giving" at top of Trinity's website. Enter the total of your winnings in the first row for "Awesome Auction for Outreach 2022"

Naturally it will be Awesome so please join us!




Daylight Saving Time ends..... at 2:00 am on Sunday, November 6!

Christian Formation classes continue


Students and teachers meet at 9:00 am downstairs in the gathering space and then break up into classes by age. Look for the signs outside each classroom door.

The Fall Schedule is as follows:


November 6, 13, 20 (No Sunday School on Nov. 27)

The First Friday Fellowship group will meet on the <u>second</u> Friday in November!


Please join us on **November 11** at 6:00 pm for Martinmas—for food, fellowship and to hear the story of Saint Martin.

Book Studies


The Book Study continues......



Together we are reading and discussing the following books: "Begin Again: James Baldwin's America and Its Urgent Lessons for Our Own," by Eddie S. Glaude, Jr., and "Do the Work! An Anti-Racist Activity Book," by W. Kamau Bell and Kate Schatz.

We will meet, in-person, on November 14, November 28, and (if necessary) December 12 from 6:30 - 8:00 pm in the Parish Hall.

As a capstone activity, we will be visiting the Black Holocaust Museum in Milwaukee on Sunday afternoon, December 4 (details to follow). This will be a joint field trip with members of the Trinity Church EYC (Episcopal Youth Community).

You need not plan to read the books or participate in the book discussions in order to take part in the field trip, but we hope some of you will accompany us in the reading and discussions — we are particularly looking forward to working through some of the activities in "Do the Work!" For simplicity's sake, we are asking folks who will be a part of the reading group to obtain their own copies of the texts.
